Higher trade in Asian vegetable oil overnight. US soybeans, corn and wheat area on the defensive on large crop production prospects. US SBO is higher and meal lower. USD was up 7 points earlier this morning and WTI down 71 cents. US soybean conditions were up one point while corn was unchanged. Spring wheat improved 3 points. The US high pressure ridge for the US is now projected to be short lived. IA, NE, and OH are in need of additional rain. StoneX sees big soybean and corn crops (yields 54.2 and 182.4). Yesterday's NASS crush report was seen supportive for soybean oil. Soybean and Corn Advisory sees Argentina's 2021-22 soybean crop at 52MMT, 2 million above this year. USDA is at 50MMT for 2020-21 and 50 for 2019-20. UGA lowered their view of the Ukraine rapeseed crop to 2.93MMT from 3.33 million previously. Thailand seeks 192,600 tons of wheat and 107,700 tons of feed barley. Japan is in for 130,295 tons of food wheat. Managed money shortened their net short position in Chicago wheat yesterday by 10,000 contracts to nearly flat.





#### Corn.

- US soybeans, corn and wheat area on the defensive on large crop production prospects.
- USD was up 9 points earlier this morning and WTI down 70 cents.
- UGA: Ukraine 2020-21 corn estimate was raised to 38.9 million tons, a record, versus 36.8MMT earlier. Exports may reach 33MMT tons vs 31m tons expected earlier.
- Heat and dryness remain a concern for parts of Ukraine and Romania.
- IA, NE, and OH are in need of additional rain.
- US corn conditions were unchanged at 72% G/E, at trade expectations, and compare to 57% a year ago. Corn dough 39% vs 22% last week, and 20% a year ago. Corn silking 92% vs 82% last week, and 72% a year ago.
- StoneX: US corn yield and production: 182.4/15.320 billion; soybeans: 54.2/4.496 billion
- USDA US corn export inspections as of July 30, 2020 were 716,127 tons, within a range of trade expectations, below 840,796 tons previous week and compares to 645,822 tons year ago. Major countries included Japan for 324,900 tons, Mexico for 228,658 tons, and Colombia for 86,284 tons.
- Bloomberg: "Corn starch plants in China, the second-biggest consumer of the grain, are running at about 60% of capacity, according to SHZQ Futures, adding some have halted or scaled back output on costs. The government is expected to release feed-grade wheat, said the China National Grain and Oils Information Center."
- US corn usage for ethanol production rebounded to 379 million bushels for June versus 300 million in May and 245 million in April. Year ago, corn use was 456 million. Sorghum use fell to a multi-month low of 2.3 million.



• US soybeans are lower on large crop production prospects. Higher trade in Asian vegetable oil overnight. Note canola oil prices in China hit a 7-year high. US SBO is higher and meal lower. Yesterday's NASS crush report was seen supportive for soybean oil.

China canola oil



- CBOT registrations for soybean oil were down 2 (Bunge).
- We heard China bought at least 8 cargoes of US and Brazilian soybeans on Monday. 4 traded out of the Gulf for Oct/Nov shipment and 4-6 out of Brazil for Mar/Apr.
- Soybean and Corn Advisory sees Argentina's 2021-22 soybean crop at 52MMT, 2 million above this year. USDA is at 53.5 MMT for 2020-21 and 50 for 2019-20.
- StoneX: US corn yield and production: 182.4/15.320 billion; soybeans: 54.2/4.496 billion
- US soybean conditions were reported at 73% G/E vs 72% last week, and 54% a year ago. Trade was looking for unchanged. Soybeans blooming 85% G/E vs 76% last week, and 68% a year ago.
- UGA lowered their view of the Ukraine rapeseed crop to 2.93MMT from 3.33 million previously.
- Rotterdam values this morning showed soybean oil for the Sep/Oct position was up 7 euros from this
  time previous session, rapeseed oil up about 3 in the nearby, and soybean meal when imported from
  South America unchanged to up \$3/ton.
- Offshore values this morning was leading CBOT soybean oil 25 lower and meal \$2.30 higher.
- China cash crush margins as of this morning, using our calculation, were 136 cents per bushel (150 previous) and compares to 150 cents a week ago and 79 cents around this time last year.

- The European Union imported 1.37 million tons of soybean imports during the July 1 and August 2 period, 6 percent below the same period year ago. EU rapeseed imports reached 90,415 tons, down 68%.
- USDA US soybean export inspections as of July 30, 2020 were 551,543 tons, within a range of trade expectations, above 504,645 tons previous week and compares to 1,032,874 tons year ago. Major countries included Egypt for 87,811 tons, Indonesia for 83,715 tons, and China Main for 71,977 tons.
- The US June crush was reported at 177.3 million bushels, 0.6 bushel below a Bloomberg trade guess below 179.5 million for May 2020, and well above 157.6 million for June 2019. But on a daily adjusted basis, the crush was 5.91 million bushels per day, up from 5.79 million during the month of May. The largest surprise was soybean oil stocks. At the end of June, they fell to 2.271 billion pounds from 2.447 billion in May, 72 million pounds below the average trade guess, and smallest since December. Note the soybean oil yield was 11.48, up from 11.46 for May. Soybean meal stocks of 462,000 short tons are down from 498,000 previous month.

### Wheat

- US wheat futures are lower on harvest pressure, large production prospects for Russia and Australia (now forecast 1-3 MMT above USDA's 26 MMT estimate), and fund selling.
- Managed money are near flat for CBOT Chicago wheat.

- Russia's AgMin: wheat yields rose to 3.66 tons/hectare as of Aug. 3, up 0.05 tons/hectare from a year earlier. Yesterday IKAR increased their estimate for the 2020-21 Russian wheat crop to 79.5MMT from 78 million previously.
- Romania's wheat crop could fall 40 percent to 5.5-5.6 million tons, according to the AgMin.
- US spring wheat harvesting progress is slowly picking up. It advanced 4 points to 5 percent and compares to 2 percent a year ago. The trade was looking for 8 percent.
- Spring wheat conditions increased 3 points to 73% and compare to 70% last week, and 73% a year ago. This was a surprise. The trade was looking for unchanged.
- Winter wheat harvest was reported at 85%, below 89% trade estimate, and compares to 81% last week and 80% a year ago.
- Paris December wheat was down 0.25 euros at 180.50.
- EU soft wheat exports as of July 1 reached 635,453 tons by Aug. 2, 68% below the same period a year ago.
- USDA US all-wheat export inspections as of July 30, 2020 were 500,110 tons, within a range of trade expectations, below 544,010 tons previous week and compares to 416,177 tons year ago. Major countries included Philippines for 102,832 tons, Japan for 91,201 tons, and Indonesia for 57,749 tons.
