



WORLD WEATHER HIGHLIGHTS FOR OCTOBER 6, 2021

- Parts of Argentina will continue to struggle for significant rain in the coming week.
- Brazil's southern crop areas will see frequent waves of rain resulting in a wetter than usual October from southeastern Paraguay and northern Rio Grande do Sul to southern Minas Gerais and Rio de Janeiro.
- Rainfall farther to the north in Brazil will be more sporadic and light in the next seven days with slowly increasing shower activity in the following week.
- U.S. weather has not changed much from that advertised Tuesday
  - The most watched weather events will be those expected this weekend and next week in northcentral parts of the U.S. and across eastern Canada's Prairies where significant rain and some snow may fall.

- Western Russia will be mild to cool with limited precipitation for a while longer
- Relief from dryness is occurring from Italy into the lower Danube River Basin in southeastern Europe.
- Eastern Australia will get some rain over the next few days and the precipitation will be most welcome to future spring and summer crop planting.
- South Africa winter crops are in good condition
- Southeast Asia rainfall has been favorable in recent weeks, but a little more rain may be needed in Sumatra and Java, Indonesia
- Southern Mexico and Central America will remain wet
- Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador and Peru will see above average rainfall in the next couple of weeks
- A tropical cyclone is evolving in the South China Sea that will threaten Vietnam and southern China with heavy rain in the coming week
- Another tropical cyclone will form in the Philippines Sea during the next few days and it could become a very large storm with movement toward Taiwan, southeastern China and perhaps the Korean Peninsula and western Japan during the next ten days
